Rainbow Service Awards 2008-2010

Each Rainbow Girl must complete ten hours of Service in each color of the Rainbow for a butterfly charm to complete her bracelet. There are, of course, seven charms for the seven colors of the Rainbow. The following recommendations are guidelines. When a Rainbow Girl has earned her 70 hours of service, Mother Advisors must verify the hours and sign the Personal Activity Log. The activity log should then be mailed to Talonda Goodrum, our Jurisdictional Chairperson in Mississippi. This program will continue through July 1, 2010. Be creative . . . and believe!

Red is for Love

Participate in a community event, such as special events that are city wide, or cleaning up parks and playgrounds. *Adopt a highway, or other road or park in your area, as a service project.*

Orange is for Religion

Attend Religious services. These can be in your church of membership or the church of a neighbor, friend, or family member. *Attend your church and invite your Rainbow sisters.*

Yellow is for Nature

Assist your Mother Advisor, State Organizer, or Grand Deputy in planning and preparing an outdoor Rainbow event in your area and attend the function. *Organize the attendance of your Assembly at the annual festal day picnic for Eastern Star, or plan another Assembly picnic or outdoor adventure.*

Green is for Immortality

Assist Grandparents, Board Members, or someone who needs help doing yard work, ironing, etc. Special needs children would appreciate some attention, too. *Adopt a special friend to help them with their yard work, house work, or running errands that they otherwise could not do.*

Blue is for Fidelity

Participate and attend a Family event, such as a reunion, anniversary, or special holiday by helping with the planning and preparation. *Organize your own family reunion, or host one for your local Assembly to bring old friends and new friends together for an event.*

Indigo is for Patriotism

Assist the Legion, Legion Auxiliary, or other Military Service Organization with projects of their choice, such as aid to military families. *Adopt a service project to provide assistance to a family with a parent away on military service, send shoeboxes to our soldiers overseas, or collect old cell phones to do the same.*

Violet is for Service

Assist at a Masonic Organization's Fundraiser or Special project of their choice. *Attend and assist in the CHIPS program for the Grand Lodge of Mississippi or the annual children's Christmas party for the Wahabi Shiners in Jackson.*
